Closure of Iconic Church

It was announced last month that St. Vincent’s Church, Sunday’s Well is to close at the end of this month. Bishop Buckley & Fr Eamonn Devlin, the Provincial of the Vincentian Order gave the sad news recently with deep regret. St Vincent’s Church has been a centre of worship and a beacon of faith for the people of Sunday’s Well and the environs over the last 160 years.

The church and adjoining buildings (now owned by UCC) were built in 1856 as a house of formation for the Vincentian Order here in Cork and the church was part of the Cathedral parish.

The Vincentian Order originally resided in what is now the old section of the Mercy Hospital.

Over the years the Vincentian Priests and Brothers have undertaken huge work in the area of Education, Chaplaincy and Pastoral Care in and around the city of Cork.


In 1973 Bishop Lucey made St. Vincent’s a Parish in its own right and subsequently a new primary school was constructed with donations from benefactors near and far. The Church was not only a centre of Worship but was also a vehicle of catechism and faith formation.

In the late 1960’s the Vincentians opened up the house of formation to accommodate lay students attending UCC.

In the 1980’s Fr Gearóid O’Sullivan was on the staff of UCC Department of Education and Fr Bill Clarke was Chaplain to the Deaf, a reminder to us of the wonderful work of the Priests in the Order.

Sadly with dwindling numbers in vocations and in people attending Church and supporting the upkeep of the Parish it was decided that St. Vincent’s, Sunday’s Well would re-join the Cathedral Parish in 2015.

The decline in vocations and Church attendance has resulted in the full closure of the Church at the end of this month. Sadly this is a reality that will have to be faced by other Parishes in the years to come. We commend the great work of the Vincentians to God’s bountiful grace and we pray for an increase in vocations to the priesthood & religious life.
